EVALUATION OF THE TEST

It is possible to get 100 points from the exam.

Points from exercises/labs/workshops are not counted.

Test points are not summed from multiple exam attempts.

Evaluation at the test:

- The examination takes place in bulk - 3 dates according to the examination rules of the University of West Bohemia are determined at the beginning of the semester, other dates are not written, generally.
It is up to each student whether to attend the deadline, i.e. if the term is not used, one term is actually lost.
- The number of exam places is not limited, but it is necessary to have a credit registered in the PORTAL that you must bring to the exam.
- Students are signed up for the exam in the standard way via PORTAL, no-show for the exam without serious reason is rated as not good.
A credit must be entered in the portal before the test.
- The examination takes place in writing and oral form.
The written part is followed by the oral part.
It is necessary to book all the day.
